# HOTEL BOOKING INFORMATION



Westercon 74 will take place at the Tonopah Convention Center **A** with additional programming in the Mizpah Club Ballroom **B**, the Belvada Hotel **1**, and Mizpah Hotel **2**. We have special rates at the Belvada, Mizpah, and the Old Brewery Hostel **3**. The other downtown hotels are the Jim Butler Inn & Suites **4** and Best Western Hi-Desert Inn **5**, all of which are within walking distance of the Convention Center. Other Tonopah hotels include the World-Famous Clown Motel **6**, National 9 Inn **7**, Comfort Inn **8**, and Tonopah Station Hotel **9**, which are between 0.5–1.2 miles (1–2 km) from the Convention Center.

Book directly with the hotels. We do not have a housing bureau. Rates at the hotels other than the Belvada/Mizpah/Hostel are not guaranteed. Contact [facilities@Westercon74.org](mailto:facilities@Westercon74.org) with questions.

Rates are for 1 or 2 people, except when listed as \$/\$/\$\$, in which case they are for 1/2/3/4 people. Rates are rounded up to the next-highest dollar. Rates do not include 9% occupancy tax.
