#### **More Than Burgers**

The Pittman Cafe at the Mizpah Hotel provides good quality food. You many notice many burgers on the menu -- the Cline family, who own the Mizpah, also raise the grass fed beef served. There is a daily dinner special -- Friday night it was Irish stew, and Saturday offered Tokyo style salmon. The restaurant is a tad understaffed (if only they could put their ghosts to work) but the servers are nice. Check it out. Dinner is served 5-9 every day.

#### Laundry

Because my time at Westercon is part of a nine day trip I was running short of clean shirts. Thus Sunday morning I headed to The Tonopah Station to use their laundromat. To reach it, find the entrance labeled "Stage Stop Cafe" and just inside on the left one should be able to buy a single load liquid detergent for one dollar. Then I was directed to the casino cashier cage which is next to the cafe entrance where I bought three dollars in quarters. Next I followed the "Public Restrooms" signs which also lead to the Laundromat. Honestly the Laundromat needs a good sweeping and general spruce up; but it is better than nothing.

A very limited number of COVID-19 Antigen Rapid Test packages are available for Westercon Attendees during the convention.

If you feel symptoms of COVID-19 then please stay in your hotel room. Call Fred Moulton between 8AM and 8PM and a test package will be left at your hotel room door for any Westercon Attending member staying in a hotel in Tonopah.

Each package contains two tests.

Consult with appropriate medical professionals if you test Positive or have COVID-19 symptoms.

Please do not wander around if you have COVID-19.

We have a limited number of test packages so this offer is only valid while supply lasts and only from July 1 8AM to July 4 8PM.
